

Tour J-I-A

(Williams Design Studio, Johnston's Greenhouses & Avant-Garden Shop)



Exit Hwy. #7A from Highway #115 and then head west for a few kilometers to the small town of Bethany. **Williams Design Studio and Secret Garden** ("J" on the tour) can be found on the main street at #1470. See the beautiful handmade copper sculptures and fountains along with many other items, which are created right on site. Then take a few minutes to visit the Williams' secret garden right next door. Copper fountains are placed in small ponds to give you an idea of how you can incorporate them into your own landscape. When you've finished your visit head back to highway #115.



Enter the Peterborough area via highway #115. Exit at the Parkway. Travel a short distance to the second set of lights and turn right. Follow Crawford drive until you reach **Johnston's Greenhouses** ("I" on the tour) located on the south side of the road. The garden centre contains four display ponds and several display gardens for those that wish to browse and get inspired. Displays change weekly with plants coming into bloom and reaching full potential. Head north to Lansdowne Street then east (right) to **The Carousel Restaurant** at 116 Lansdowne St E. for a hearty buffet lunch. A favourite restaurant of local residents!



Once you've completed your buffet lunch, travel to **The Avant-Garden Shop** ("A" on the tour) in downtown Peterborough via Lansdowne west to Aylmer Street heading north. Turn right when you reach Sherbrooke and travel past the liquor store. A beautiful flag outside the shop on the south side of the street welcomes you. The shop is filled with an alluring collection of functional and decorative accessories for the home and garden as well as the largest selection of bird feeders in the area. The shop features unique ornaments, wall art and statuary, premium garden tools and supplies, mailboxes and address plaques. They have many beautiful gifts for the gardener in your family.
